(b)	Structure, Operations, and Supply Chains	<ul> <li>The core operations of the company are the fabrication and installation of structural steelwork. This work is carried out:</li> <li>At a manufacturing facility in Young NSW, which employs 45 people.</li> <li>On construction sites managed by Building companies to which we supply our products and services on a subcontract basis.</li> <li>Key supply chains supporting operations are those for:</li> <li>Material inputs to production (steel sections, steel plate, surface coating supplies, welding supplies, etc.)</li> <li>Subcontracted work services, including for drafting shop drawings, and for erecting steelwork on construction sites.</li> <li>Subcontracted ancillary manufacturing services, such as galvanising, specialist processing, 3<sup>rd</sup> Party testing services, etc.</li> </ul>
