This is the 2MG SOLUTIONS modern slavery (and human trafficking) statement pursuant to the Australian Modern Slavery Act 2018 (No. 153, 2018). This Statement sets out the steps 2MG has taken to address the risk of slavery and human trafficking taking place in any of its supply chains, and in any part of its own business. It has been approved by the board of directors of 2MG SOLUTIONS PTY LTD.

Our business, structure and supply chains

2MG is an Australian company with some dealings with supplies that have resources in Sri Lanka.

Our policies on slavery and human trafficking

We will not tolerate modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. We are committed to ensuring that there is transparency in our own business and to tackling any modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains. We expect the same standards from our suppliers and contractors.

Actions taken, due Diligence processes & steps to assess and manage risks, performance indicators

In order to identify and mitigate modern slavery and human trafficking risks, we adopt a risk-based approach. Systematic review of supplier risks is an important tool used by 2MG for properly evaluating our supplier relationships. Our supplier evaluations include a questionnaire analysis and audits, whereby the suppliers' sustainability performance is assessed.

By this means we

- identify and assess potential risk areas in our business and supply chains;
- monitor potential risk areas in our business and supply chains with focus on human rights;
- mitigate the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking occurring in our business and supply chains.
