



Modern Slavery Statement – Kinetic TCo Pty Ltd

For the reporting period: 1 July 2024 – 30 June 2025



1 Reporting entity

This modern slavery statement (**Statement**) is made on behalf of Kinetic TCo Pty Ltd (ACN 601 251 067) (**Kinetic TCo**), with its registered office at Level 16, 171 Collins Street, Melbourne, Victoria 3000, on its own behalf and on behalf of its Australian subsidiaries, all of which are wholly-owned by Kinetic TCo (together, **Kinetic** or the **Group**).

This Statement has been prepared in line with the requirements of the *Modern Slavery Act 2018* (Cth) (**Act**). For the purposes of this Statement, “modern slavery” has the meaning given in section 4 of the Act.

Kinetic condemns modern slavery in all its forms and supports the objectives of the Act. Kinetic is committed to implementing proactive and effective actions to prevent and address modern slavery and mitigate the risk of modern slavery practices in its operations and supply chain.

Based on the due diligence undertaken on our clients and suppliers, Kinetic confirms no instance of modern slavery was identified in its operations or supply chains in the 2024/2025 reporting period.



2 Kinetic's structure, operations and supply chains

2.1 Structure

Kinetic TCo is the ultimate parent company of the Group. Kinetic is a global transport operator providing bus and rail operations. Kinetic TCo is incorporated in Australia with headquarters in Melbourne. The Group employs approximately 4500 people across Australia and operates a fleet of approximately 2123 buses.

2.2 Operations

Kinetic's Australian operations include the provision of bus transit services in metropolitan, rural and regional areas including airport bus services, passenger route bus services, charter services and school bus services. Kinetic operates in Australia under various branded trading names, including Kinetic and Skybus.

2.3 Supply chain

Kinetic's supply chain includes:

- / goods/products and services
- / fuel, oils, lubricants, spare parts, tyres
- / batteries and renewable energy technologies
- / uniforms
- / cleaning services
- / utilities (including telecommunications services)
- / information technology systems and services
- / security services
- / maintenance services

- / work on assets and property, including chassis/body repairs on vehicles
- / qualified tradespersons;
- / capital purchases
 - / assets e.g. buses and other vehicles
 - / property e.g. depots, offices
- / capital works
 - / works required to upgrade our assets and infrastructure e.g. the electrification of our fleet and depots
- / professional services
 - / advisory, financial, legal and audit services
- / other goods and services
 - / advertising material, such as print signages for transit advertising on buses

3 Risk of Modern Slavery in Kinetic's Operations and Supply Chains

3.1 Operations

Legislation and governance in Australia reduce the risk of modern slavery practices in our operations. Our staff are engaged on employment contracts that require compliance with either the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) or Enterprise Agreements approved by the Fair Work Commission.

3.2 Supply Chain

Kinetic has policies and procedures in place to identify where there is potential for the Group to cause, contribute to, or be linked to modern slavery practices through its supply chain.

Kinetic identifies that some essential goods for transport services originate from high risk geographies, such as fuel, oils, parts, tyres, batteries and uniforms.

Kinetic also engages some services from high risk industries, such as cleaning services.



4 Actions to assess and address modern slavery risks

4.1 Policies and procedures

Kinetic requires all employees to read and comply with its internal policies and procedures. Kinetic policies and procedures that assess and address the modern slavery risks in its operations and supply chain include:

- / Supplier Code of Conduct;
- / Procurement Mangement Procedure;
- / Procurement Policy; and
- / Ethical Sourcing & Modern Slavery Policy.

Kinetic also has policies and procedures in relation to whistleblowing which encourage employees to make protected disclosures if they are subject to, or become aware of, modern slavery practices in Kinetic's operations and supply chain.

4.2 Training

Kinetic is currently engaging with The Freedom Hub, a registered charity and social enterprise that supports survivors of modern slavery in Australia, for the purposes of co-developing and providing bespoke training for all Kinetic employees, tailored to Kinetic's operational and supply chain risks of modern slavery. This training will enhance Kinetic employees' understanding of the risks of modern slavery practices, the Act, and Kinetic's policies and procedures to assess and address the modern slavery risks in its operations and supply chain.

4.3 Due diligence

Kinetic requires high risk suppliers to complete a self assessment form on engagement.

All supplier contracts require that suppliers adhere to their modern slavery obligations under the Act and comply with Kinetic's policies and procedures on modern slavery. Kinetic will also typically negotiate to include audit rights in relation to modern slavery compliance.

High risk suppliers must complete a modern slavery questionnaire annually to declare that they do not engage in any modern slavery practices and confirm that they have internal policies and procedures in place to address the risk of modern slavery practices in their operations and supply chain.

For example:

- / **Zero emissions vehicles:** zero emission vehicles present supply chain risks for modern slavery practices involving manufacturing, a high risk industry, and parts that originate from high risk geographies. In our recent request for proposals for zero emission vehicles, SkyBus (a Kinetic brand and subsidiary group) required all vendors to complete a detailed modern slavery audit which formed the basis of a modern slavery risk analysis for procurement of zero emission vehicles. Vendors were asked to disclose risks in their supply chain and explain how those risks were identified, addressed, and mitigated.
- / **Kinetic uniforms:** Uniforms are a supply chain risk for modern slavery practices involving manufacturing, a high risk industry, and textiles that originate from high risk geographies. Kinetic assessed its key uniform supplier for modern slavery compliance on engagement. This supplier completes annual modern slavery questionnaires and undertakes independent audits of its overseas manufacturing sites.

4.4 Remediation

To date, Kinetic has not identified any instances of modern slavery practices in its operations or supply chain that require remediation. If any modern slavery practices suspected or identified in Kinetic's operations or supply chain would immediately necessitate stakeholder engagement and remedial action.



5 Assessing the effectiveness of our actions

Kinetic undertakes continuous and ongoing review of the effectiveness of its actions in assessing and addressing the risks of modern slavery practices in its operations and supply chains.

Kinetic evaluates the information that it receives from its suppliers to enable it to properly categorise supply risk and, if necessary, to promptly act on any allegations or findings of modern slavery practices.

Kinetic has also commenced an internal Supplier Risk Assessment process to help identify and monitor potential areas of modern slavery risk within its supply chain. The initial assessment focuses on Kinetic's top 20 suppliers and engages relevant stakeholders to evaluate risk exposure and strengthen mitigation measures for high-risk suppliers.

Modern slavery risks, like all risks for Kinetic, are discussed and escalated to the Group's Audit and Risk Committee and Board, as appropriate.

6 Consultation

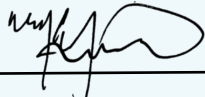
