MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

Reporting Period: 2026

This Modern Slavery Statement is made jointly by Vantris Energy Australia (formerly known as Sapura Energy Australia) and Total Marine Technology Australia Pty Ltd (together referred to as the Reporting Entities). The Reporting Entities are wholly owned subsidiaries by Vantris Energy Berhad (formerly known as Sapura Energy Berhad). This Statement is published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2018 (Cth).

Structure, Operations and Supply Chains

Vantris Energy Australia

Vantris Energy Australia (formerly known as Sapura Energy Australia) operates within the energy and marine services sector in Australia, providing specialised engineering, offshore, subsea, marine and project-related services. Its supply chain includes engineering services, marine support, equipment, materials, logistics, specialist subcontractors and labour hire.

Total Marine Technology Australia Pty Ltd

Total Marine Technology Australia Pty Ltd operates in the marine and offshore technology sector, supporting offshore and subsea operations through specialist equipment and services. Its supply chain may include Australian and international manufacturers, service providers and logistics partners.

Modern Slavery Risks

The Reporting Entities recognise that modern slavery risks may arise through global sourcing, use of contractors and subcontractors, labour hire arrangements and complex multi-tier supply chains. While risks in the direct workforce are considered low, upstream supply chain risks may exist.

Actions Taken

Actions taken include adoption of a Modern Slavery Policy, risk-based supplier due diligence, contractual human rights clauses, training and awareness initiatives, and confidential reporting mechanisms.

Assessing Effectiveness

Effectiveness is assessed through supplier monitoring, review of incidents, policy reviews and continuous improvement initiatives.
